## FAFSA Completion Events

***Class of 2024- Get assistance with completing your FAFSA!***

**Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the form students need to complete to apply for financial aid for college or trade school, such as grants and loans. It is also a graduation requirement.**

What to bring:

You will need the following items in order to complete your 2024-25 FAFSA. If you are considered a dependent student for financial aid purposes, you will also need these items for your parent(s).

- 2022 Federal Tax Return and W2s
- 2022 Untaxed Income Records, such as child support or veteran's non-education benefits
- Information on savings, investments, business assets and farm assets (if applicable)
- Driver's License (if you have one)
- Cell phone (if you have one)
- Social Security Number
- Alien Registration Card or Permanent Resident Card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Date of birth for parents
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce, or separation
- FSA ID (if you have one). To create an FSA ID, please visit [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov). Every student and at least one parent if the student is considered a dependent student needs one.
